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Summary: This bulletin supersedes TB 48-11, dated September 20, 1993, becomes effective 30 days after its publication and shall remain in effect until further notice. It reflects the establishment of a fee for non-electronically filed HMDA (Home Mortgage Disclosure Act) reports, an increase in the hourly rate for examining holding companies and affiliates, a new fee to offset the cost of conducting trust examinations and an adjustment in fees for filing Registration Statements. All other fees remain unchanged from TB 48-11.

Fee Schedules

Thrift Bulletin 48-12

Attached are the revised fee schedules for OTS. Except for the changes listed below, the fee schedules contained within this bulletin are identical to the schedules contained in TB 48-11.

The Application Fees Schedule has been amended to reflect an increase in filing fees for Securities Offering under 12 C.F.R. Part 563g, from 1/32 of one percent to 1/29 of one percent of the maximum aggregate offering price. The increase corre-

sponds to and reflects a similar increase recently made to Section 6 (b) of the Securities Act of 1934 increasing fees paid for registration statements filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission.

The Examination Fees Schedule has been amended to reflect the establishment of a new fee for trust examinations and an increase in the hourly rate for examining holding companies and affiliates. The hourly rate for examining holding companies and affiliates has increased from \$60 to \$89. The hourly rate for trust examinations will also be \$89. Trust examinations were previously conducted at no charge. OTS believes that the new fees more closely reflect the actual costs of conducting such examinations.

Finally, this bulletin establishes a new fee for non-electronically filed HMDA reports that contain in excess of 200 lines of data (see "Miscellaneous Fees Schedule"). (Each application or loan reported by an institution is one line of data.) OTS has determined that, on average, such reports cost \$90 more to profiled cess than electronically reports-a cost OTS cannot underwrite. Accordingly, the new \$.20 per line fee is designed to offset the added cost and to encourage more HMDA reporters to file electronically.
