<u>ORDER</u>

On February 11, 1993, Respondent Janet F. Acker filed an application for a change in control of Interstate National Bank, Dallas, Texas ("Interstate"). The Office of the Comptroller of the Currency ("OCC") disapproved the application on August 23, 1993. Respondent then requested a hearing, which was held before Administrative Law Judge Arthur L. Shipe. On February 24, 1995, the ALJ issued his Recommended Decision, and the case is now pending before the Comptroller for a final decision.

It has come to the Comptroller's attention that on June 23, 1995, Respondent signed an agreement in which she conveyed her right to acquire approximately 83% of the stock of Interstate to Fidelity National Bank, N.A., University Park, Texas. The Comptroller directs both parties to file with him, within 21 days of the date of this Order, their views on whether

this proceeding is now moot and therefore should be dismissed and, if so, whether the underlying disapproval should be vacated.
