On May 11, 1995, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit remanded the Comptroller's Decision and Order in this case for further proceedings on the amount of restitution the Respondent should make.

If negotiations are unsuccessful, the parties shall file, within 21 calendar days of the date of this Order, their views on the appropriate amount of restitution and whether the Comptroller should direct the Administrative Law Judge to take evidence. Each party will have five calendar days to respond to the other's submission.
